What does the word mean?

Math 10:14  
Luka 10:41  
Gal. 4:6  
1 Cor. 5:7 } as the lesson, "to be troubled with care"  
"to be anxious" "distracted"

What means the 1611 to "thought"?

A good rendering, is 1611. The word "thought" meant rather, <sup>anxiety</sup> <sup>conscience</sup>  
It meant that pre-occupation of fear which respects the balance of the <sup>mind</sup>  
turns the whole soul into words of dejection, worry, anxiety. <sup>thought</sup>  
a) One of the historians says, "Queen Catherine died of thought."  
b) Shakespeare, Anthony & Cleopatra,  
Cleopatra says to Enobarbus, "What shall we do, Enobarbus?"  
The answer is, "Think and die" i.e., fear, gives away,  
succumbs to depression, anxiety, all the influences that control the heart.

So here in the text,  
and in Math. 10:19.

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[Calvinism modern]  
A great device of the last century has pointed out the earnest  
logic of Jesus in the Gospels. His doctrine is not insignificant,  
theoretically, but "a metaphysical god-talk in the clouds". It is  
downright common sense, - strong, robust, practical common sense.  
Let us see if Jesus and the great devils are right.

I. 6:25

Caring care, conveying anxiety, anxious thought, is contrary to all the lessons of nature which show it to be unnecessary.

The faults of the car } they have not the superior advantages of the horse  
The habits of the field } can a glass world change, being more durable } of the world...

(Q) How to save the nature of the organism

You must trust God for the parts that a life, body  
There is a lesson in the maintaining of life, food, clothing, shelter.

The main thing, and look to that.

(Q) A father whose son is much delicate, declining day by day. He, not concerning his boy, he replies: "I am always most anxious that he should wear well his gloves for his feet, his shoes of the best quality of leather, never appear without being so dressed as to attract the admiring attention..."

So you say 6:25.

Forgetful care in mind of years. Luke 16:1-9 These birds get up early, need have but forgetting it is a great thing.

Forgetful - to the child, adult - to the hand, saving, insurance  
Forgetting - thinking and possession - saving, insurance

II. 6:31

Caring care is contrary to all the lessons of nature (the principles of the world) which show it to be like the hathors. hathors

The health full of negotiation, fear, perturbation & creating the god, driven by the hand "your father's command". He knows I P. 8:7 care
