TYPICAL COLORS AND SUBSTANCES

I. COLORS

A meaning: when God told to use blue, scarlet, purple, then green, yellow not answer the same purpose.

"Blue and purple and scarlet"

1. The Tabernacle itself Ex. 26:1
26:2 a curtain of goats' hair covered it
2. The Vail Ex. 26:31
3. The door of the Tabernacle Ex. 26:36
4. The gate of the court Ex. 27:16
5. Garments for Aaron Ex. 28:2, 5, 6, 8, 15, 33

BLUE: The heavenly character of our Lord.
He who came down from heaven
" " " who ascended back to heaven
" " " was in truth the heavenly one.

SCARLET: His sufferings.
Mt. 27:28 "a scarlet robe"

PURPLE: His kingly glory
The wealth of His divine power
Mt. 8:15 robe for woe
Mt. 16:4 Tyria, purple

FINE TWINED LINEN: Ex. 26:1, 31; 27:16 etc.
Rev. 19:8 "for the fine linen is the righteousness (saints)
So the linen, the righteousness of the true himself."

II. SUBSTANCES.

Ex. 25:3 "gold and silver and brass"

GOLD: Obedience

SILVER: Redemption
of "redemption money"

BRASS: Judgment
The great altar, the bronze altar.
Rev. 1:15 "feet like unto fine brass... burn"

III. THE FIVE SUBSTANCES MENTIONED
IN CONNECTION WITH THE MEAL OFFERING
^{WHEAT}
Leviticus 2:1-16

- 3 commanded: oil, frankincense, salt
2 forbidden: leaven, honey.

OIL: 2:1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 15, 16 The Holy Spirit
Gen. 21:20 = the fabled origin of oil. 25:8
Job. 4:1-6 the lampstand, the olive tree, "my spirit"

FRANKINCENSE: 2:1, 2, 15, 16
Prayer: the whole life offered unto God.
Eccl. 30:34-38

SALT: 2:13
While leaven, honey corrupt, salt prevents it.
Mt. 5:13 "salt of the earth"
Col. 4:6 "speak to one another with salt"

Forbidden:

- 2:11 Leaven } both in the same category here, because
2:11 HONEY: } honey was used in order times to
produce fermentation - so included, like
fermented dough. [Today, use sugar].

IV. Some things that have various meanings,
as water, fire.

FIRE:

1. God's presence.
Burning bush -
On mt Sinai
pillar of fire (cloud) above the Israelites
Deuteronomy
2. God's acceptance
when fire fell upon a sacrifice, denoted God's acceptance.
