THE WAR

66 year rebellion - Antioch, Masada, Roman power  
Cestius Gallus, 70 AD Roman to def. Defeat. 64 AD  
Nero - disaster for Jews, Vespasian.

Galilee - Josephus in chains  
20,000 sold  
6,000 taken from gift to Nero, cost

Nero dies - 68 AD  
Titus left to proceed war  
Josephus Roman. Appeal for surrender

The War  
Feb. 66 AD - Aug. 70 AD.

66 AD. long smouldering discontent, fanned by the zealots, burst forth into open rebellion. Palaces, public buildings, first by the crazed multitude. Roman Force of Antonia (and last) the Temple captured, Roman garrison slain.

Cestius Gallus, gov. of Syria, came with his legions, 30,000 men besieged the city. Was defeated. In his impetuous retreat toward Caesarea, at Beth Horan, 6,000 Roman soldiers slain.

All Palestine aflame, in revolt. Wherever Jews or Romans, war.

Nero, Equea, could not countenance such a revolt. would be disastrous to the Empire. Other provinces revolt. Sent Vespasian <sup>public</sup> with Roman legions, fallen from Syria, rather Josephus commander of the nation army. Subdued. Josephus in chains.

30,400 sold as slaves  
6,000 chosen would suit as gift & used to build wall <sup>at Jerusalem</sup> ~~at Jerusalem~~ but diverted to build pagan temple.

Vespasian, conquering all <sup>around</sup> the whole province, begins the siege of Jerusalem.  
Nero dies - Vitellius slain

- legions in Judea proclaim Vespasian emperor. Legions throughout the East.
- ① Legions to be acclaimed emperor, into an em left to pursue the war.
  - ② Josephus had predicted his overthrow, claim with off, showed, need to make appeal to the <sup>governments</sup> for peace. would the Roman army throughout the war.
