## Why God Permitted Adam's Transgression

The Holy Spirit, perfect workmanship of God.  
But there is another spirit - of destruction, evil.

(1) Creation. Gen 1:1 Perfect, from hands of God.  
Gen 1:2 Then something happened.

(2) Eden. The man. Animal life. Garden.  
Then the fall: ground of that thorn, animal of fear, shame, mean death.

(3) The Nativity. Christ was, Birth, when, angels, they leads.  
Cross. Set eyes, death. Handled back to God on a Roman spear.

Why God allow?

Not foresee what Adam would do? attendant consequence  
Yes. "Acts 15:18. Known unto God... to all his posterity (for us  
in the lesson of our sinfulness?)

But God also knew that Rom. 5:15, 206.  
What is the better thing to come out of the fall of man?

## I. The Gift of Christ - God Incarnate - Who Loved Us and Gave Himself For Us.

If Adam not fallen, Christ not take our nature upon him. The Word made flesh, that he might redeem us from our sins. The story of redemption, Christ.

If Adam not fallen, no cross, that amazing display of God's love to mankind. Could not have been said to atonement of the hosts of heaven. "God so loved... you..."

If Adam not fallen, no gospel of redemption. 1 Peter 1:12 "angels desire..." can not know. Never fell. Faith - forgiveness - justification - adoption.

## II. The Revelation of God's Heart as well as God's Power

Might have loved God as Creator: "O God, how excellent is thy name in all the earth." <sup>of the incarnate</sup> Christ as the reverse image of God, the creature, his joy" (John 1:3)
