Psalm 85:6

"Will Thou Not Revive Us Again?"

Ps 137 in captivity

Ps 126 back again

Ps 85 but a lack of spirit, devotion, faithfulness
drifted away in the process of immaturity.
an appeal for guiding revival.

1. The address: "O God of our salvation"
Not - O God, Creator of heavens, earth, Christy, Omnipotent, Sovereign...
But - O God of my experience, whom I know, meet...

Praying to the God of our experience:

Gen. 35:1 "God said to Jacob. Arise... Bethel... and an altar unto the
God that appeared unto thee." 35:7 "The God will answer
me in the day of distress..."

When raised..... began ministry... needed help...
(?) Dr. J. P. Brook, in assembly his faith in studies, in dark times,
lost to a night when after a revival nearly ready to be turned aside,
built, your ministry to God, the teacher/min rolled away.

2. The request: "Will thou not revive us again?"

"I know what thou canst do"
my heart entrusted. you touched it
- soul lost - you saved it
- life without God - you gave

The personal appeal

8. Daniel 6:20-22 "O Daniel, is thy God able to deliver thee..."
"O God, my God hath sent his angel..."

9. Paul Phil 4:19 "my God shall supply all your need..."

Now: O God, touch my heart as you did
revive my soul again
come once more into my life

2. This is reversal

(1) when God's people get right

Isa. 57:1, 2

Isa. 66:18

(2) When turned in prayer

Isa. 66:8

(3) when God's people commit themselves to God's work
of the farmer. God sends our share, rain. But he must sow, plant.

(4) when we boldly witness for Christ.

f. a greater in Acts (no different in gospels)

(5) when we work in the anointing of the Holy Spirit.

He is the Executor of the God's will

that is the Holy Spirit. Condition... saving faith... regeneration
takes the word, applying it.

The Holy Spirit makes the difference.
