

Report from the Online Waldorf Library

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Since 2001, the Online Waldorf Library has helped facilitate research and answer questions on a wide variety of topics. Recently, several parenting related questions have come to us, specifically about how to work with the effects of the pandemic on children going through their six-year and nine-year changes. The OWL offers eBooks that address these topics, namely, *Completing the Circle*, by Thomas Poplawski, and the article by the same author, "Paradise Lost: the Nine Year Change"; *Rubicon*, a compilation of what Rudolf Steiner has written about this time of transition; *You're Not the Boss of Me*, edited by Ruth Ker and published by WECAN; and, from Gateways #48, the article, "Observing the Six-Year Change," also by Ruth Ker. The OWL is very much interested in sharing more recent articles and studies on this subject.

In 2022, the OWL had 210,000 site visits from all English-speaking countries, as well as from India, Mexico, Spain, Argentina, Chile, and China.

We continue to offer an ever-expanding number of eBooks, articles, and journal articles available in pdf format, which can be accessed by downloading free software from Adobe Reader. New articles in Spanish and English are posted every month and can be accessed from the home page (www.waldorflibrary.org) and by clicking on *Artículos en Espanol* and *Articles*.

In our Journals section, we are pleased to continue to share all back issues of the *Research Bulletin* and *Gateways*.

As noted in previous reports, now available in our Journals section are back issues (1949 to 2009) of the *Golden Blade*. This remarkable annual intended to bring the outlook of anthroposophy to bear on questions and activities of interest in a way that may have lasting value, right up to the present. It was founded in 1949 by Charles Davy and Arnold Freeman, who were its first editors; the journal owes much to the twenty-three years of editorial guidance of Adam Bittleston.
