## Speakers' Biographies

**John A. Merrigan** is a partner with the law firm DLA Piper US LLP in its Washington, D.C. office. Mr. Merrigan serves as co-chair of the firm's Federal Affairs Practice Group. He began law practice in 1973 with the law firm Verner Liipfert, which merged with DLA Piper in 2002. With Berl Bernhard and Harry McPherson, Mr. Merrigan founded Verner Liipfert's federal affairs practice. From 1996 until 2000, he served as Chairman of the Democratic Business Council, the leading forum for business interests within the Democratic National Party. From 2002 through 2004 he served as Middle Atlantic Finance Chairman in the Kerry for President Campaign. He serves on the Board of Directors of the New Democratic Network and on the board of Children Uniting Nations, a foundation which fosters mentoring among inner city children. He also is a member of the Washington Legal Foundation's Legal Policy Advisory Board.
