**John T. Boese** is Of Counsel with Fried, Frank, Shriver & Jacobson LLP in its Washington, DC office, where he was a partner for almost 30 years. He joined the firm after five years as a trial attorney in the Civil Division of the United States Department of Justice. Mr. Boese is a nationally recognized expert on the civil False Claims Act. He is the author of the book, *Civil False Claims and Qui Tam Actions* (Wolters Kluwer Law & Business 4th ed.), a comprehensive, two-volume treatise on the law and *qui tam* enforcement at both the federal and state levels, which was initially published in 1993 and is routinely cited as authority by courts at all levels.
