



World Vision's THRIVE program is a proven, highimpact solution to end extreme poverty, with an ambitious goal to reach 10 million people in 11 countries by 2030.

THRIVE equips smallholder farmers-most living on less than \$3 per day—with tools they need to lift themselves out of extreme poverty, including Biblical Empowered Worldview training, access to savings groups, increasing market knowledge and access, and lending to savings groups.

Independent studies show that THRIVE delivers exceptional results: Household incomes increased up to 10 times in Tanzania and participating families averaged \$3,375 in economic gain.

These same studies revealed that every \$1 invested in

THRIVE results in \$6.67 in economic benefit to participating families.

By combining evidence-based tools and faith-driven purpose, THRIVE empowers families to lift themselves out of poverty for good.

Our eight-year business plan, THRIVE 2030, operates in 11 countries with a projected cost of \$345 million.

We seek to raise \$253 million in philanthropic funding from U.S. donor partners by 2030. The remaining funding will come from local World Vision offices in the 11 countries.

# Extreme poverty

is defined as income of less than \$3.00 per person per day.

We focus on rural farmers, who make up two-thirds of those living in extreme poverty.

You can buy three limes for about \$3.00. Yet that is what 808 million people live onor less-each day according to the World Bank's updated definition of extreme poverty. The majority of them live in sub-Saharan Africa, South Asia, and Central America.

Two-thirds of all people living in extreme poverty are smallholder farmers-and at least half of them are women.

Shocks like droughts, floods, disease outbreaks, and changing weather patterns create more difficulties for farmers to feed their families, and often push them further into extreme poverty.

Most farmers and rural small business owners in the communities we serve lack the empowered mindset, financial tools, and business knowledge needed to earn more money and break the cycle of extreme poverty.

Children suffer most when parents can't afford to feed them more than one small meal a day, put a decent roof over their heads, or support their education.



World Vision's proven THRIVE approach equips families living in extreme poverty to move up the economic ladder. Our four sequential evidence-based interventions lead to improved incomes and more resilient families.

#### **Biblical Empowered Worldview**

This powerful Scripture-based curriculum helps people shift their mindsets from dependency and despondency to confidence, responsibility, and accountability as created by God.

#### **Savings Groups**

To put this empowered mindset into practice, we help community members-primarily women-set up their own groups to save money together and expand their social networks and relationships.

They also learn financial basics and how to manage household finances, and they lend to one another to start or improve a business.

## **Market Knowledge and Access**

For savings and producer groups ready for the next step, we provide business planning and access to vital market information, which leads to income diversification, increased profits, and improved resilience.

#### **Lending to Savings Groups**

Through this innovative product, small loans are offered to mature savings groups, providing more capital for the groups to lend to their members. This enables them to take even bigger steps toward growing or improving their farms and businesses.


## **Activity and Progress** Reporting
