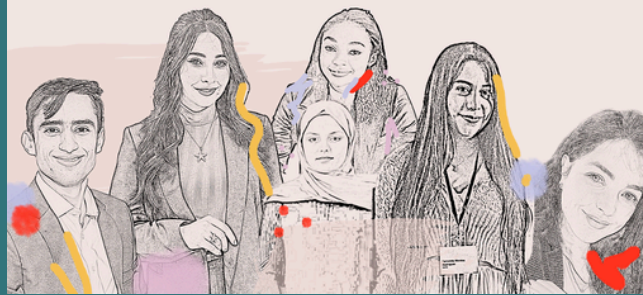

## The Refugee Education Council

### What is the REC?

The REC was established in February 2021 by the Government of Canada as part of its Together for Learning campaign. The REC is an advisory body made up of displaced learners, educators, and community leaders from around the world to advocate for access to quality, gender-transformative, and inclusive education. The REC members also participate in key global education platforms to add their voices of lived experience on the international stage.

The REC is hosted by World Vision Canada and it works closely with Global Affairs Canada, Canadian International Education Policy Working Group (CIEPWG), multilateral partners and youth networks globally.



# The REC's Key Pillars

01

## Consultation and Advisory Engagements

Serve as a trusted advisory body to GAC, Canadian civil society and global education platforms on gender response and inclusive global education, particularly for refugees.

## Advocacy & Representation of Lived Experience

Ensure that refugee voices, lived experiences and perspectives meaningfully shape global education spaces, priorities, and commitments.

## Awareness Raising & Communications

Expand the visibility of refugee and displaced youth perspectives, particularly girls and women, in public and policy conversations.

## Building Alliances

Work alongside like-minded partners to strengthen global education ecosystem for refugee and displaced youth.
