
## HAROLD'S ORIGINAL MONOGRAMS computer fonts

Original collection of 16 fonts to create 2- or 3-letter oval- or diamond-shaped monograms in regular and bold weights



- 1. Install the fonts and relaunch the program.
- 2. Type ? [question mark] to get the outside ring (optional).
- 3. The left-hand letters are located at the lowercase positions. Type the left initial.
- 4. The large center letters are located at the UPPERCASE positions. Type the center initial.
- 5. The right-hand letters are somewhat trickier to locate. Use this chart:

After the right-hand initial is typed, the monogram is complete and the cursor will move to the right.

For a one-letter monogram, type ? [question mark] for the ring; < [less] for the blank in the left position; [CAPITAL INITIAL]; > [greater] for the blank in the right position.

For an A&B style design, type `[grave accent] to produce the ampersand in the center.

In the 2-letter monogram fonts, skip step 5 above; the monogram is complete after the second letter is typed.
