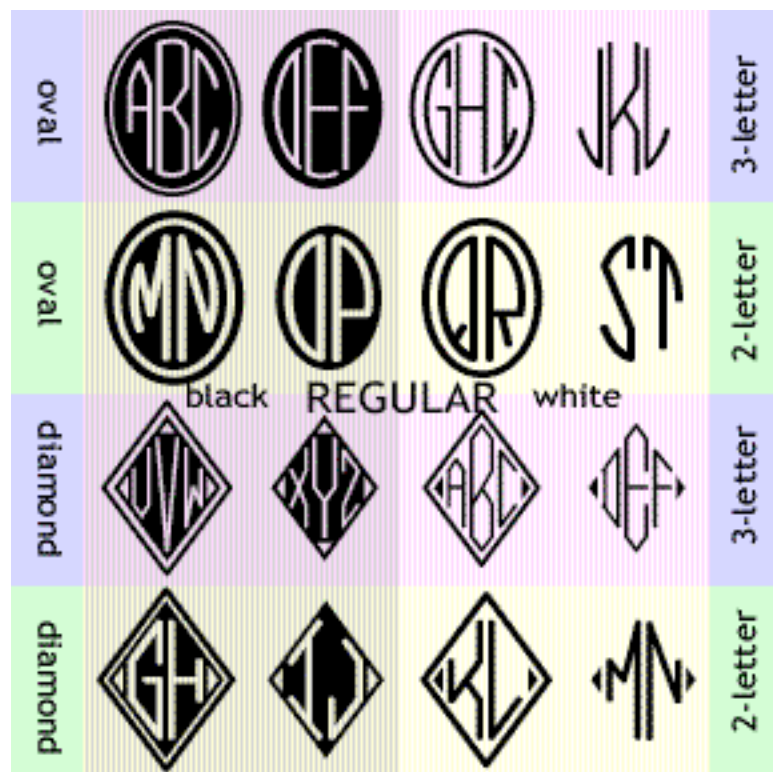

Original collection of 16 fonts to create 2- or 3-letter oval- or diamond-shaped monograms in regular and bold weights



1. Install the fonts and relaunch the program.
2. Type ? [question mark] to get the outside ring (optional).
3. The left-hand letters are located at the lowercase positions. Type the left initial.
4. The large center letters are located at the UPPERCASE positions. Type the center initial.
5. The right-hand letters are somewhat trickier to locate. Use this chart:
 A ... 1 B ... 2 C ... 3 D ... 4 E ... 5 F ... 6 G ... 7 H ... 8 I ... 9 J ... 0
 K ... ! L ... @ M ... # N ... \$ O ... % P ... ^ Q ... & R ... * S ... (T ...)
 U ... - or _ V ... = or + W ... [or { X ...] or } Y ... \ or | Z ... ; or :

After the right-hand initial is typed, the monogram is complete and the cursor will move to the right.

For a one-letter monogram, type ? [question mark] for the ring; < [less] for the blank in the left position; [CAPITAL INITIAL]; > [greater] for the blank in the right position.

For an A&B style design, type ` [grave accent] to produce the ampersand in the center.

In the 2-letter monogram fonts, skip step 5 above; the monogram is complete after the second letter is typed.
