The organiser

I will only participate in the tournament as a ringer if there is an odd number of players, and will not win any of the prizes if I do so. My job is to set up the event and answer any questions that may arise during games, as well as giving time reminders and calling last activation. In the event I do have to play, store staff will give out the timings etc.

Venue

Justplay Games is located in the city centre. It is very close (5 minute walk) to Queen square bus station, and both Lime Street train station and Moorefields train stations.

Entry

What you need

Crew models (built and based, painting not required)

Rulebooks

Official Wyrd stat cards and upgrades

Fate Deck (with malifaux suits)

Measuring instrument

Markers/tokens as required

Sportsmanship

Malifaux is designed to be fun for all players.

Players are expected to behave civilly and respectfully at all times. When asked, players should provide the information and statistics for models as well as any relevant additional public information. Players must be open and honest about the rules of their models. Activations should be played in a timely manner; players should not waste time.

There is zero tolerance for cheating. If the organiser determines that a player is cheating, the player will be immediately disqualified from the tournament. Players are given a single warning when the organiser judges their behaviour toward other players or the organiser to be unacceptable. If the behaviour persists and the organiser determines the player to be a disruption, it is within the organiser's authority to disqualify the player from the tournament.

Conversion and Proxies

Proxy models and conversions are allowed in M2E Tournaments at the Organiser's discretion. If you wish to use either, please ok this before the tournament, either on twitter, facebook, email or early on in the morning before round one begins.

Painting

There is no painting requirement for this event. There will however be a prize, player voted, for best painted 50ss from the faction you are using on the day. If you wish to enter please set up your crew at lunchtime.

Prizes

There will be trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd. A spoon will be presented to the best loser (last place). Favourite opponent and best painted, and runner up will also receive an award.

Strategies and Schemes

Will be generated via crewfaux two weeks before the event, and published on the forum, twitter and facebook event page.

Scoring

3 TPs for a win 1 TP for a draw 0 for a loss .

First tiebreaker will be points differential, if this is tied it will be points scored, and if still tied it will go to strength of schedule.
